ISLAMABAD APRIL 10, 2018: President Mamnoon Hussain has said that National Accountability Bureau (NAB) officers should be very honest and unbiased because corruption free administration and decisions are the hallmarks of NAB.

The President said this while taking to Chairman, NAB Justice (R) Javed Igbal who called on him at the Aiwan-e-Sadr, Islamabad on Tuesday. Chairman NAB also presented Annual Report – 2017 of his organization to the President.
