He added that full-fledged activities will start at the Gwadar Port in the near future and which will play an important role in the development and prosperity of the region.

The President said this while talking to a delegation of Pak-China Joint Chamber of Commerce who called on him at the Aiwan-e-Sadr, Islamabad on Wednesday.
