TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The bidder shall upload National Identity Card and provide complete present address and active telephone number.
- It is mandatory to deposit an amount of Rs.5,000/- in the shape of Pay Order in favour of Deputy Director (General) P.S(Public) as bidder registration fee for participation in auction, which shall be returned except for highest bidder for its subsequent adjustment. Those not registering themselves shall not be eligible for participation in auction.
- The successful bidder(s) (after acceptance of highest bid) has to deposit 50% payment of total bid and remaining amount must be deposited within three days of auction approval. In case of default, advance money shall be forfeited.
- All existing/prevaling government taxes at the prescribed rates shall be charged in addition to the bid amount.
- The successful bidder(s) will have to lift auctioned motorcycles within three days failing which, the deposited amount will be forfeited without sending any further notice.
- The procuring agency reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids proposals in accordance with Rules-33 of PPRA Rules-2004.
